Multicultural Festival Recap

- Potentially shifting up performances in timeline next year
- Possibly eliminate food truck next year because there's so much food at the event
- Expenses >\$1,000; Income \$910 from donations. Grant used from BVSD DEI to pay for performances, hopefully we can get it again next year
- 26 tables this year compared to 19 last year; over half families returned from last year, new families hosted. Planning for next year, have as many if not more tables
- Overspent on bowls, tablecloths, decorations, all supplies that can be reused for next year as we have a lot leftover

- Next year planning has started for teachers, budget, events
- Survey for parent/caregivers on their expertise, career, and cultural experiences by topic so teachers can refer to it for guest speakers and presentations.
- FET meeting brought up family sharing, parents sitting in on classes, sharing cultural identities. Embed our cultures across Mesa in the classrooms. Many new families coming to Mesa are international families or families that selected Mesa based on DEI committee and involvement.

- Fundraising Theme is Mesa Oasis:
 - Phase 1 of groundcover: \$10k is needed for breeze (crushed rock, first layer)
 - Phase 2 of groundcover: \$10k with adding areas of turf (goes on top of breeze)
 - Asking kids if they raise \$50, they'll be entered into a drawing for prizes

- Kids involved in fundraising, emphasizing participation; grade level and school level prizes (ex. class gets extra recess). If kid raises more than \$50, enter into drawing
